Please advise whether these residents received communication regarding the name change and what they need to do.

Service

Staff have been previously unaware of this address point issue. It is likely to have originated when the Greenlane Road extension was constructed by NZTA. The Land Information property database retains the Gordonton Road addresses for both properties. It is therefore very unlikely the name change was ever made "official" by the Agency.

Staff are currently in consultation with the owners to find a solution for this issue.

Dependent on the owner's wishes, Council could post a new white over blue Street name blade at the start of extension indicating Gordonton Road.

Grass Verges Policy

The grass verges policy was enacted on the I of October 2016. Council wrote to approximately 650 property owners whose verges were maintained by Council contractors to inform them of the policy conditions and offer the opportunity to apply for an exemption. The exemption was to be only provided if the residences met central requirements, which were related to age, illness or condition of berm. Of the approximately 650 letters posted, Council received 112 responses requesting an exemption. Of the 112 exemption letters 58% were granted.

Since the 1st of October 2016 Council has received 24 service requests related to verge maintenance.
