AND Amend Rule 14.9.1.3 P3 Support structure associated with amateur radio configurations to be clearer and replace with the following: (a) <u>Support structures associated with amateur radio configurations that comply with all of the following: (i) For wire aerials of less than 115mm in outside diameter, no more than six support poles per site provided that: A. The maximum height of the support poles does not exceed the maximum building height in the zone in which they are located by more than 2m; B. The setback and height in relation to boundary shall not apply to these support poles; (ii) Where guy wire are used these must not exceed 12mm in diameter; (iii) At no point must any guy wire or aerial overhang the boundary; (iv) For each site, one support structure can exceed the maximum stated height applying to buildings in the applicable zone by more than 2m provided that: A.
