DECISION

[1] I have before me an application by Chapter Two Limited for a temporary authority in respect of premises situated at 4 - 65 Devine Road TAMAHERE known as "Four Square Tamahere".

[2] The application for the temporary authority was filed with the Waikato District Licensing Office on 26th January 2024 and is the second such application made by this applicant. The first temporary authority expires on 20th February 2024.

[3] The applicant has sought this temporary authority on the grounds that they have purchased the business, have applied for the required planning certificates and wishes to continue to trade within the conditions of the underlying licence for the premises whilst they continue towards lodging an application for a substantive licence.

[4] The inspector has filed a report on the application and does not oppose the granting of the temporary authority. The Police have not opposed the application.

[5] I am satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard, and I am satisfied that the application meets the Purpose and Object of the Act, accordingly, I grant the temporary authority.

[6] This temporary authority authorises the applicant to carry on the sale and supply of alcohol with the same conditions contained within the underlying licence number 14/OFF/05/2023.

[7] The temporary authority is issued for the period not exceeding three months and may issue immediately to take effect from 21st February 2024.

[8] A copy of this temporary authority is to be displayed alongside a copy of the underlying licence within the premises.
