

IN THE MATTER of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

AND

IN THE MATTER of an application by Warwick John Cleave for the renewal of a Manager's Certificate pursuant to s.224 of the Act

DECISION

I am satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard as set out in s.227 of the Act and I grant the renewal of the applicant's Manager's Certificate.

[1] This is an application by Warwick John Cleave for renewal of a Manager's Certificate.

[2] No report under s.225 of the Act has been received which raises matters in opposition to the application. Accordingly, the matter is dealt with on the papers.

Criteria for determining the application:

[3] In deciding whether to issue a special licence the committee must consider the matters detailed in s.227 of the Act. These are:

- (a) the applicant's suitability to be a manager;
- (b) any convictions recorded against the applicant since the certificate was issued or last renewed;
- (c) the manner in which the manager has managed the sale and supply of alcohol pursuant to the licence with the aim of contributing to the reduction of alcohol-related harm; and
- (d) any matters dealt with in any report made under section 225.

Reasons and decision:

[4] The Inspector's report notes that there is no reason to believe that the applicant is not a suitable person to hold a Manager's Certificate. The Police report does not note any convictions recorded against the applicant. The applicant has several years' relevant experience managing licensed premises. The applicant is currently employed in the industry, and there is no evidence to suggest that the applicant has not appropriately managed the sale and supply of alcohol pursuant to the licence with the aim of contributing to the reduction of alcohol-related harm.

[5] The Inspector has not identified any issues of concern in her report to suggest that a certificate should not be issued. The Police report similarly does not raise any issues of concern.

[6] I am satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard as set out in s.227 of the Act and I grant the renewal of the applicant's Manager's Certificate.

[7] Accordingly, I renew the certificate until 13 March 2027, that being three years from the most recent date of expiry, and authorise the issue of a notice of renewal.
