**DECISION**

[1] I have before me an application by Invivo & Co Limited for the renewal of an off licence in respect of premises situated at 55 Te Kauwhata Road, Te Kauwhata known as "www.invivowines.com".

[2] The application was made prior to the expiry of the underlying off licence.

[3] The nature of the business is that of a complementary remote seller.

[4] Reports on the application were received from an Inspector, the Medical Officer of Health and the Police and offer no opposition.

[5] The application was duly advertised and did not attract any public objection.

[6] I am satisfied as to the matters which I must have regard as set out in s.105 of the Act, and I am satisfied that the application meets the purpose and object of the Act. Accordingly, I grant the applicant a renewal of the underlying off licence with the, **following conditions:**

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day.
- (b) Alcohol may be delivered under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:  
**Monday to Sunday 6.00am to 11.00pm**
- (C) The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
  - i. Display appropriate information at every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
  - ii. Request age declaration from all customers before orders are placed and after any sale is completed in accordance with regulation 14 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Regulations 2013.

- (d) The following information must be displayed on the internet site in a prominent place, in any catalogue used by the licence holder and on every receipt issued for any alcohol sold via the internet site:
  - i. The licence holder's name, the licence number, and the date on which the licence expires.
- (e) The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the management of the premises are observed:
  - i. All staff will be trained in their responsibilities under the Act.
- (f) The sale or delivery of alcohol is authorised from the premises generally. The premises situated at 55 Te Kauwhata Road, Te Kauwhata, are more precisely identified in a plan date stamped as received by the Waikato District Licensing Committee on 4 March 2020.

[7] The licence may issue for a period of three (3) years upon payment of any outstanding fee.

[8] I refer any party who wishes to appeal this decision or part of this decision to sections 154 through to 158 of the Act.
